### **Hybrid JD Adjunct Faculty Positions Available**

Mitchell Hamline School of Law is currently hiring adjunct faculty for the Executive JD Program to assist with two doctrinal courses: TORTs: The common Law Process or Criminal Law: Statutory Interpretation for fall 2017. The Executive JD consists of an intensive in-person experiential capstone week, a leadership weekend workshop, and online weekly modules that span 14 weeks of the semester. We seek expert practitioners who will assist out full time faculty in providing timely and valuable feedback to students' weekly discussions, assignments, or assessments. Each adjunct will be assigned a group of students and will need to be available by e-mail, chat, or telephone to respond to student questions. Applicants are expected to participate in a mandatory training that will cover the petrology of the program and online platform. JD is required.
